

English

Children will be studying a longer book and some non-fiction texts – these will vary according to the class and year group. All teachers will be developing the children’s ability to write for a purpose and they will develop their skills in spelling, punctuation and grammar.



Maths

Work will begin with place value and then addition and subtraction before moving on to multiplication and division. The children will develop their knowledge and fluency before reasoning and problem solving with these skills.



Science

Plants, animals and habitats.
Children will learn about:

- The parts of plants, how plants grow and the life cycle of a plant.
- Food chains
- Classification
- Teeth and the digestive system.

RE

Finding out about the Bible and Christianity

Music

Depending on the class and year group, we will be learning to play an instrument including using our own voices.

Spanish

We will be developing our language and vocabulary in Spanish and finding out about Spain.

Diversity within the Community Year 3/4

Project

We will be looking at our local area and grappling with the question, ‘How does a school of great diversity impact on the local community?’ As a result, we will be looking at the Dene and the local environment and the people who have impacted it in the past and present.

Computing

Children will be refreshing their e-safety knowledge in this block of work. Children will use this time to continue to develop their basic computing skills on programs such as word and powerpoint.

PE

Depending on the class and year group, a range of PE activities will be covered, including Metafit (high intensity training alongside meditation and relaxation) and fundamental PE skills such as balance and movement. Y4 will also have swimming lessons.

Art

We will be developing our basic drawing skills and completing observational drawing including still life.
