
## Reception Newsletter

## What the children will be learning...

The children will be sharing lots of traditional tales this half term and exploring different ways in which we can retell the story. We will continue to explore the composition of numbers to 10 using a range of different maths resources. We have become super starts at identifying some 2D shapes so Mrs Fleming is going to challenge us to some 3D shapes this next half term. In phonics we will begin to read some longer words with 2 digraphs and consolidate our knowledge on our tricky words! At the end of the half term we will touch on the Easter story ahead of the Easter half term break.

## How can you help your child?

Please continue to share stories with your child, including the library book which can be chosen on a Thursday morning as well as your child's guided reading book which gets sent home on a Friday. Please leave a comment in your child's reading record so that we are able to see how you are finding their reading at home. Please continue to challenge your child with some tricky words. These are words which your child will come across more frequently in their reading and writing but are unable to segment and blend. Miss Hymers will be providing a list for you to take home as well as being available on Seesaw. Please can we ask that you access activities which are being set each weekend on Seesaw. If for whatever reason you are unable to get onto Seesaw, please speak to Miss Hymers.
