After every block the children are assessed so their power teacher may change.

Attendance is also really important, especially in Year 6. We will be having class treats and whole school rewards for children who come into school everyday and on time!

In Tawny Owls class your child will be expected to:

- Always try their best

We expect your child to have their reading book in school **EVERY DAY.** Every day is a reading day here at Broadwood and they are given opportunities to read. It's really important to read *regularly* at home-every day if possible! Your child has been given a 'Reading Journal'. In this they should write all the books they read at home and school. They should read every night and write the page they have read up to, so we can check on their reading progress. It's important not just to read the words but to think about the meaning of what they are actually reading. As your child is in Upper Key Stage 2, they will be encouraged to take responsibility for changing their own books from our selection in school. Please encourage your child by hearing them read regularly asking them which books they are reading, as well as taking them to the library. If your child has not brought their reading folder into school, three times in a half term, you will be notified by the class

What will we be learning ?

English:- We are now in Power Groups ask your child who their Literacy teacher is. They will covering a range of reading and writing objectives



<u>Maths</u> - We are now in Power Groups ask your child who their Maths teacher is. They will covering a range of reading and writing objectives



<u>Topic</u> — As our topic work is Ancient Civilisations. We are beginning with Ancient Greece, their way of life, democracy, food and education . Then we will be learning about Ancient Egypt including mummification and Gods.

<u>Science</u>— The children will be given opportunities to conduct scientific Investigations. This work will provide opportunities for the children to develop their writing. Ours science topic is "Forces"

<u>Computing</u>— In computing the children will be reminded of e safety and then they will begin computer programming
