What is the PE and Sports Premium?

"The dedicated primary PE and Sport Premium, which was announced in March 2013 and began in September 2013, goes directly to primary school head teachers so that they can decide how best to use it to provide sporting activities for pupils." It can be used for a range of purposes in order to promote PE and sports and raise standards of teaching and learning.

Vision

All pupils leaving Broadwood Primary School will be physically literate, with the knowledge skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.
