Maths

This term we will start to combine two or more parts to make a whole and start to use the '=' sign to show the sum of two parts. We will also be finding pairs of numbers to 10, as well as adding and subtracting 1 from any number. We will then go onto explaining what happens when 2 is added or subtracted from odd/ even numbers.

How can I help?

English- Writing

We will be writing a recount of our visit to St Mary's lighthouse. Here, we will be focusing on time adverbials, such as: first, then, next and finally. We will then go onto sequencing sentences to write short narratives, beginning to punctuate sentences with full stops and exclamation marks, as well as using a capital letter for names of people and places and the personal pronoun 'l'.

English– Reading

We will continue to have daily phonics lessons teaching phase 5 sounds. We also have 3 guided and individual reading sessions, so each child will be heard reading at least 4 times per week.

How can I help?

Please read with your children. We will continue to send a library and a reading book home with your child on a Friday. If you could read and listen to your child read at least once a week it would have a huge impact on their reading progress!
