'One particular fun game was the parachute!'

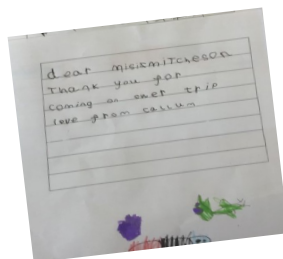
'I enjoyed going to the camp, it was really good and we all enjoyed it. I want to thank all of the staff for going and looking after us.'
