
Year 2 – Spring Term

Year 2 team

Maths This half term, we will be looking at shape. Using the terms symmetry and finding lines of symmetry. The children will also become familiar with the language of shape such as words like vertices, edges and faces. The children will also have the opportunity to draw 2D shapes and recognise shapes in different

orientations. Later on in the term, we will begin to look at multiplication and



division. Counting in steps of 2,3,5 and 10 but then looking at groups and arrays. We are then aiming for the children to become familiar with the 2,5 and 10 times tables.

How can I help?

Can you find shapes in everyday life? What shapes can you see in a house? What about 3D shapes in the kitchen cupboard? Can you find a cereal box, open it flat and see what it looks like when spread out on the floor? Does the biscuit box look the same?

English



This term we will be using the book 'Little Red Reading Hood' a traditional tale with a twist. We will be using this book to retell traditional tales in familiar settings. The children will be using drama and role play in supporting writing speech between two characters, as well writing their

own version. The children will also be rehearsing poems out loud and creating their own.

We will continue to teach phonics every morning to some children, while others will focus on spelling patterns. Group reading will continue to take place three times a week.

How can I help?

Please listen to your child read their book at home and ensure it comes into school regularly. Lexia will continue to used in class so any further support with this at home would be greatly appreciated.

Curriculum

This term the children will be learning all about animals and humans in science, the importance of nutrition and a healthy lifestyle. In PSHE we will also be learning keeping safe. In history we will be deepening our knowledge of the work that Mary Seacole did in her life and why it is important we remember her. We will also be having a special visitor coming to talk to the children all about Jewish celebrations in RE.
