What the children will be learning...

The children will begin a new topic in History this term as we examine the Stone Age to Bronze Age period of our countries history. In English we will, therefore, read Stone Age Boy. Maths will see us begin to multiply and divide by 2 digit numbers before exploring measurement. Science will begin looking at light, both natural and man made. Computing lessons will explore digital media and Spanish will focus on the subject of Ancient Britains. PE will see year 3 learn the skills necessary for invasion games. This term will also see the chance to take part in an after school Cooking Club run by C.H.E.F.F. In PSHE we will be examining ways that we can keep safe as well as discussing the dangers of alcohol and cigarettes.
